Discussion Questions

1. Read Galatians 1:1-10. In verse one, Paul reminds the Galatian believers of his authority as an Apostle. He had a life-transforming encounter with God that literally knocked him off his feet (Acts 9). Have you ever experienced a significant spiritual transformation in your life? If so, please share.
2. Read Galatians 6:2. The law of Christ is the law of love. In what ways is the law of Christ more demanding than the Old Testament Law? How have you experienced this in your own life?
3. Consider the following quote: "The law is like an MRI scan that reveals our disease but provides no cure. We respond to this revelation of disease in one of three ways: by trying harder and, thus, only compounding our condemnation, by giving up in despair, or by hoping completely in God's merciful and gracious promises rather than our own works." Share your thoughts about this statement and how you've seen any of these three responses in your own life.
4. As Christians, we are no longer enslaved to sin. We have been freed from the bondage of sin and serve a new Master. We have been given the best resource possible to be obedient to God, and that is the person of the Holy Spirit. How has the Spirit worked in your life in recent days? In what areas of your life do you need to yield to the Spirit?
