Titus - Part 6 | Titus 2:9-10 | week of October 15

GETTING STARTED

- What word or phrase would you use to describe your relationship with your boss?

Read Titus 2:9-10.

DISCUSS & APPLY

- Look back at Titus 2:1, the command which governs all of 2:1-10. What must Titus do? According to 2:2-8, what has this involved so far?

- Verses 9-10 are addressed to slaves (or “bondservants” in the ESV). How does this teaching also apply to modern-day workers?

- How does being “well-pleasing” rather than “argumentative” in our service demonstrate the grace of God?

- How does “showing all good faith” (i.e., being trustworthy) rather than “pilfering” (i.e., stealing - time or money) demonstrate the grace of God?
- According to Paul, what will happen if members of the church live as he has instructed (2:10)?
- How does being a good servant (or employee) adorn the gospel? How have you seen this demonstrated in your workplace? How does this need to be demonstrated in your workplace?
- What is one way you can be compellingly countercultural at work this week?

- Write a prayer, asking God to make you a more godly servant (in whatever capacity you serve) this week.
