GETTING STARTED

- What motivations do people have for living the way God wants?
- Which are good motivations, and which are not, do you think?

Read Titus 2:11-14.

DISCUSS & APPLY

- What has appeared, and what is significant about that (v. 11)? What event do you think Paul is referring to?
- What will appear (v. 13)?
- What did the Jesus who *will* appear do when he *first* appeared (v. 14)? Why?
- What does Paul say Christians are waiting for (v. 13)?

- How should knowing that we live between grace and glory shape our attitude towards:
 - Our mistakes?

 - Our regrets?

 - The parts of life we find wonderful?

 - The parts of life we find difficult?

- How would it affect our attitudes and lives if we forget either that God's grace has already appeared, or that God's glory will one day appear?

- What does God's grace teach us to do in life (v. 12)?

- How does God's grace teach us to do these things?

- How do God's grace and glory change:
 - Our view of our future (and therefore our present)?

 - How we love others and God?

 - How we see ourselves?

- How do each of these things teach us to live in the way verse 12 says?

NEXT STEPS

- Make a list of ways in which you are personally struggling to say “no” to ungodliness. Pray that a renewed focus on God’s grace and glory would help you to walk in godliness.
