

David and Goliath: Faith > Fear

1 Samuel 17:32-37; 43-47

SERMON POINTS

- Goliath enters the scene (FEAR)
- David enters the scene (FAITH)
- Because Jesus slayed our GREATEST GIANT, we can face our lesser giants with faith

KEY TAKEAWAY → 1. Unbelief is the greater Giant in this story and in our own. 2. Recalling God's faithfulness in the past is what strengthens our faith in the present

QUESTIONS:

Q: Do you have any fears you are willing to share? (e.g. Fear of spiders; flying etc)

Q: What has been your greatest experience of fear?

Q: What has been your greatest experience of faith—not abstract, but concrete (meaning stepping out and acting on faith)?

Q: What in your life requires faith right now? If you can't think of anything, why do you think that is? What will you do about it?

Q: What would be something that, if you did it, would require you to trust the Lord through prayer and faith? What is holding you back?

Q: What is a clear example of God's faithfulness in the past to you? How can that example of his faithfulness in the past fuel your faith in the present?
