**JESUS EXCLUSIVELY AND ENTIRELY PROVIDES
ETERNAL SPIRITUAL SATISFACTION.**

OUTLINE

Self-declaring eternal truth about Himself . . .

1. Jesus is the bread of life (v. 35).
2. Jesus is the bread of life for me (v. 35).
3. Jesus is the bread of life for me only if I eat (v. 35).

REFLECT

1. How does Jesus’ statement, “I am the bread of life,” change the way you live today?
2. Have you ever been fully satisfied with anyone or anything other than Jesus?
3. What is the link between enjoying God and glorifying God?

PRAY

1. Ask God to reveal to you things that are competing with Jesus to fully satisfy you.
2. Ask Jesus to give you a greater desire for Him.
3. Pray for help to show the world that Jesus is your satisfaction and your joy.

DISCUSS

1. What is the hunger and thirst that Jesus speaks of in verse 35?
2. What are some of the “lesser breads” you go to for satisfaction?
3. How do we enjoy gifts from God without allowing them to take the place of Jesus?
4. Jesus offers full satisfaction. How does this truth help you fight sin?
