So Jesus again said to them, “Truly, truly, I say to you, I am the door of the sheep. All who came before me are thieves and robbers, but the sheep did not listen to them. I am the door. If anyone enters by me, he will be saved and will go in and out and find pasture. The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy. I came that they may have life and have it abundantly.” —John 10:7-10

BIG IDEA

Jesus is the only door every sinner must find and every saint will follow.

OUTLINE

If I believe Jesus is the door...

1. I have found unending goodness (vv. 7-8)
2. I have found unending safety (v. 9)
3. I have found unending provision (v. 9b)
4. I have found unending excess (v. 10)

REFLECT

- Read John 10:1-10.
- What other doors have you gone through looking for satisfaction other than Jesus?
- How will Jesus' unending goodness impact the way you live this week?

PRAY

- Ask God to reveal to you pastures that appeal to you more than Jesus.
- Ask God to help you grow in your understanding of His unending provision as the Good Shepherd.
- Pray that God will make you more attentive and obedient to the Shepherd's voice this week.

DISCUSS

- Jesus is the Door. What is your relationship to Him [today](#)?
- Jesus provides unending safety. How have you experienced that this week?
- The Shepherd provides the best pasture for His sheep. Which lesser pastures do you find your heart drawn to and why?
- Jesus offers unending excess to His sheep. How does this produce contentment in your life?
