Home Group Questions

These questions are provided for your further study and application of today's sermon. Large Group

2. Rather than working through a series of questions about prayer, take this time to pray, interceding on behalf of someone that you know who is lost. Use the following as a guide for your prayers.

Praying for the lost:

Lord, pour out Your Spirit upon (name of person) and

- Convict him of his sin and separation from You. (John 16:8)
- Reveal to him who You are and what Christ has done for him.
- Open the eyes of his understanding. (Ephesians 1:18) Remove the spiritual blindness. (2 Corinthians 4:4)
- Draw him to Yourself in a powerful fashion. (John 6:44)
- Bind Satan from him. Guard him from Satan stealing Your word from him. (Matthew 12:19)
- Pray for grace and mercy to surround him.
- Help me to be willing and anxious to be the means by which You save and deliver him. Show me how to lead him to Christ.
- Send people across his path to bring him a witness of Christ.
