"An Irresistible Call"
Hebrews 11:23; Exodus 3:1-10
Week of October 2, 2016

Central Truth: God calls his people to launch out in daring faith.

1. Moses was born to be the deliverer of Israel. He spent the first 40 years of his life in prominence as a prince in Pharaoh's court and the next 40 years in obscurity as a shepherd in Midian before finally being called by God at the age of 80. Considering Moses life...
 - a. What can we learn about God's timetables for our lives? What do you think was the reason God delayed?
 - b. What can we learn about humility in waiting for God?
2. Read Exodus 3:1-10. God called Moses to a huge task that required daring faith.
 - a. When you are sure God is speaking to you, and a specific "Yes, Lord" is expected of you, what things influence your answer?
 - b. Do you know the calling that God has on your life? (see Romans 11:29; 1 Corinthians 1:26; Ephesians 1:18; Philippians 3:14; 2 Thessalonians 1:11)
 - c. What happens when we respond to the calling God gives us? What happens when we don't?
3. Some people use prayer as an excuse to procrastinate. Is there something you should stop praying about and start doing in response to God's call?
4. God often calls people to take action because of hurt, pain, or sin (Ex. 3:7). What obstacles or challenges facing people in our world might God call you as an individual or us as a small group to take action against?
5. What one insight from the teaching or today's discussion seems most personally significant to you right now?
