### Discussion Questions

1. Did you do anything special or go anywhere during the Easter season? If so, please share.
2. Read 1 Corinthians 15:1-10. One “piece of the puzzle” for the validity of the resurrection of Jesus Christ is the church itself, especially in how the church demonstrates the love of Jesus Christ. How have you personally experienced the love of Jesus through others at our church?
3. In verses 3-4, Paul presents a crucial piece of evidence for the validity of the resurrection. It’s as if he was bringing a written statement into a court of law. The written word is powerful. There’s a sense of permanence. In what ways have you seen the “written word” in our society used in a negative way? How can you use the “written word” to build others up? How can you use the Word of God to encourage others?
4. One of the greatest examples of transformation and hope is found in none other than the author of 1 Corinthians, the Apostle Paul himself. While our spiritual journey may be quite different from Paul’s, how has God transformed your life? How is God working on you currently?
