Discussion Questions

1. Share about a memorable trip to one of the natural wonders (i.e. God's creation) of the world.
2. Read Genesis 1:3-23. Within the Christian community, Young Earth proponents hold to the view that the Earth is approximately 6000 years old, while Old Earth proponents hold to the view that the Earth is approximately 4.5 billion years old. In light of Sunday's sermon, what should be our attitude when it comes to understanding the age of the Earth, and how should we treat other Christians who might hold a different view?
3. Whenever we see the phrase, "God saw that it was good" in Genesis 1, it's an indication that God is preparing creation for something special. That something special is mankind. What does this tell us about God's attention to detail and about our role in His plan?
4. Read Job 38, verses 4-7, 12, and 38. Based on Sunday's sermon, how are those in today's modern society no better off than those in ancient times when it comes to our society's attitude toward creation? How can we as Christians point to creation to encourage those in our lives who do not have a relationship with God?
