Discussion Questions

1. Read Genesis 2:4-25. The creation account in chapter one is seen from a macro perspective (big and vast) while the same account is viewed from a micro perspective (intimate) in chapter two. How do the two perspectives give us a glimpse into the very nature of God (see also Psalm 121:1-4)?
2. How have you experienced/witnessed both the spectacular greatness of God in your life as well as His deep, intimate care in your life?
3. Eden was a beautiful place. In a sense, it looked ahead to the beauty of the tabernacle in Exodus 25-27. The glory of God's presence is often seen through the beauty of our physical surroundings. We can't underestimate what our physical surroundings can do for the soul. What kinds of physical surroundings (natural or man made) are you drawn toward?
4. In chapter two, we are introduced to the first family unit in Adam and Eve. We are also given the first mandate of marriage, which is to become one. Oneness begins with a shift in allegiance from parents to spouse. In what ways is this a universal mandate? How might this look different from one marriage to another (think different cultures)?
