Outline from Sunday's Message:

1. Anticipation is an expression of faith.
2. Anticipation is contagious.
3. Anticipation leads to breakthrough.

Discussion Questions:

1. Read Hebrews 11:1, 7. Anticipation is an expression of faith. Someone once said, "Ten people gather to pray for rain in a time of drought. One person brings an umbrella. That's anticipation!" Is there an area in your life in which God is calling you to step out in faith? If so, please share. How can you "anticipate" that God will work in the situation?
2. Read Acts 16:14-15, 30-34. Anticipation is contagious. In these two passages, we see the work of the Holy Spirit spreading from household to household. In the New Testament, the term "household" extended beyond nuclear families and included relatives, servants, even people associated to the family by vocation/business. What "circles" are you part of throughout the week (e.g. family, work, school, neighborhood, etc.)? How is God calling you to spread the Gospel in your circles? What steps can you take to carry this out?
3. Read Joshua 6:1-21. Anticipation leads to breakthrough. Share about a difficult situation in your life in which you experienced breakthrough. If you can't think of one, please share about an area in your life in which you need to see breakthrough.
