“Make It Count”

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Psalm 90:1-17 (ESV)

THE TRUTH ABOUT MY TIME ON EARTH

One day, it will **come to an end** (vv. 1-10).

- My time has a limit. There comes a day when everyone shifts from asking, "How old am I?" to "How much time do I have left?" Life travels at the speed of age.
- I must grasp how fleeting my life is and not assume that tomorrow will be like today and today will be like yesterday.

GIVEN THAT MY TIME IS FLEETING...

QUESTION: How am I to spend my **remaining days** (vv. 10-12)?

- Wisdom comes when you live as though your days are numbered (Psalm 39:4-5).

ANSWER: By putting myself in the bigger **work, purpose, and story of God** (vv. 12-17, 1-4).

- The more real the brevity of life is, the more awakened I am to the things of God.
- The point of life is not for me to be the point, but to make God the point.
- The “heart of wisdom” (v. 12) is viewing my remaining days in the bigger context of God’s work, purpose and story. It is about living for something bigger than myself, putting myself in the center of what God is doing.

KEY QUESTION

Am I making the **best use** of my time for God?
(Ephesians 5:15-17)

- We measure the fullness of life, not by the number of days lived, but by the difference that that life made for God in the short time that we all have on earth.

CENTRAL TRUTH:

Make your remaining days count for God.
