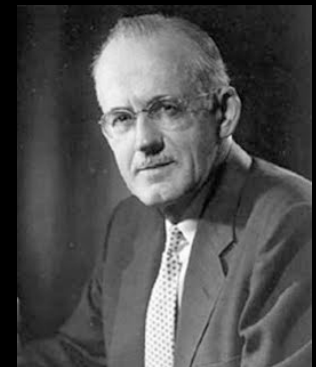
III. WISDOM ON WEALTH
