Lamech – Genesis 4:19, 23-24

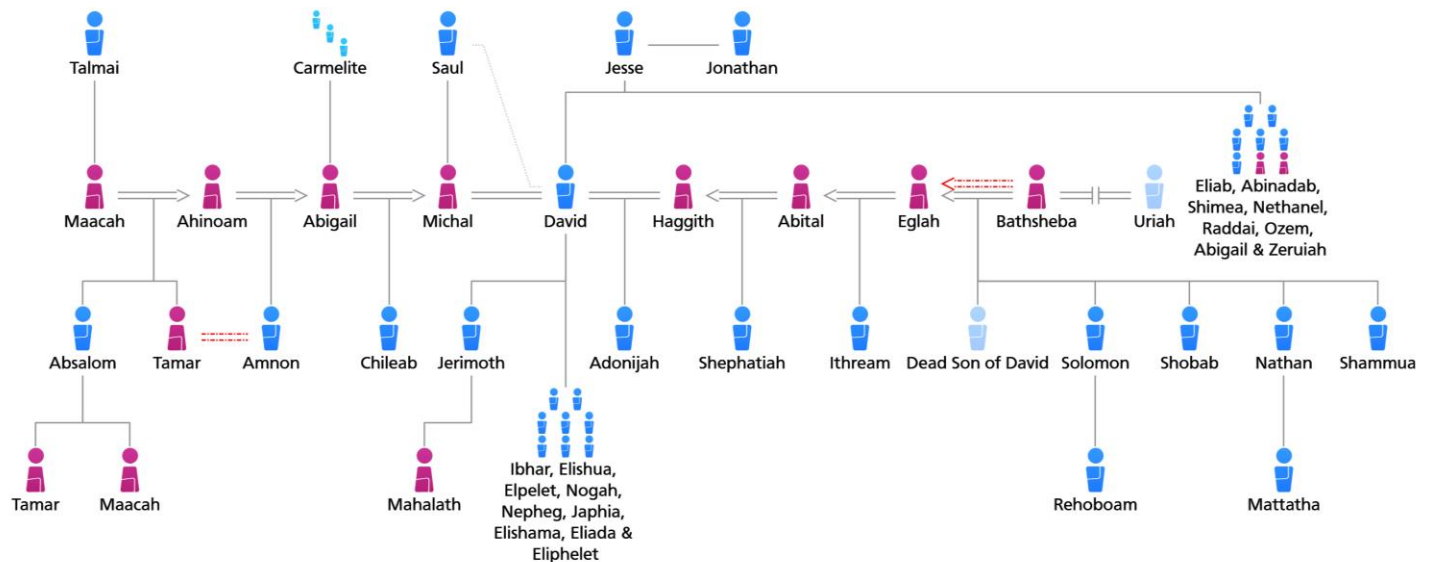
Abraham – Genesis 16:1-3; 25:1-6

Jacob – Genesis 30:4, 9

B. Plural Marriage for Leaders Forbidden – Deuteronomy 17:14–17

C. Plural Marriage for Leaders Problematic

1. David – 1 Chronicles 3:1–9; 1 Samuel 25:39–44



2. Solomon – 1 Kings 11:1–13

Ahab, wicked Israelite northern king and husband of Jezebel, had several other wives. 1 Kings 20:7

Rehoboam, Solomon's son, had 18 wives, 60 concubines, 28 sons, and 60 daughters. 2 Chronicles 11:21

Abijah, king of Judah, had 14 wives with 22 sons and 16 daughters. 2 Chronicles 13:21
