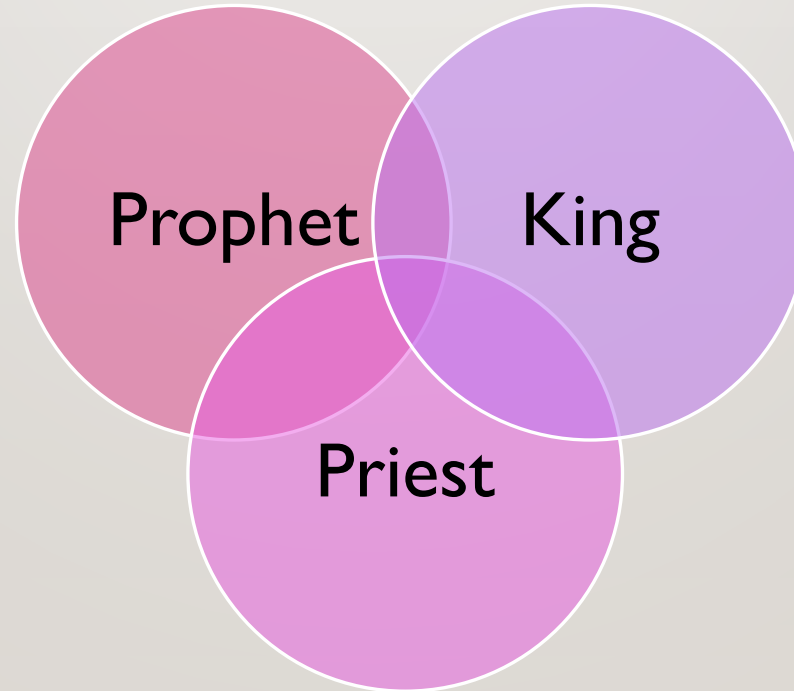
# REVIEW: MEDIATOR

- The **means**— His Word and Spirit

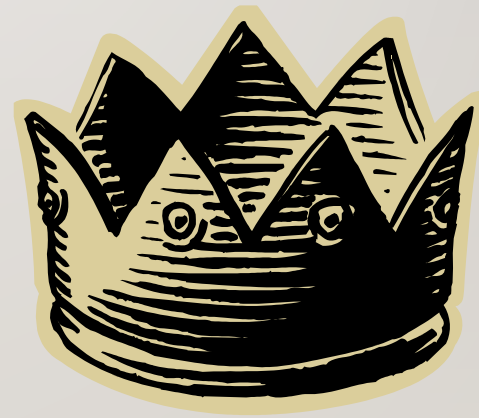




# REVIEW: KING

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- Subduing a people to Himself
- Ruling and defending His people
- Restraining and conquering His and our enemies

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- His once offering up of Himself a sacrifice
- making continual intercession for us

# REVIEW: HUMILIATION KEY TEXT

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- <sup>6</sup> who, though he was in the form of God, did not count equality with God a thing to be grasped, <sup>7</sup> but made himself nothing, taking the form of a servant, being born in the likeness of men. <sup>8</sup> And being found in human form, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross. (Phil. 2:6–8)

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# KEY TEXT

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- <sup>9</sup> Therefore God has highly exalted him and bestowed on him the name that is above every name, <sup>10</sup> so that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, <sup>11</sup> and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father. (Philippians 2:9-11)

# HUMBLER TO BE EXALTED

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## HUMILIATION

- Remember the key text? Paul tells us that Jesus voluntarily humbled Himself
- Phil. 2:6-8

## EXALTATION

- By humbling Himself, Jesus fulfilled the covenant. For this God the Father highly exalted Him
- Phil 2:9-10

# WHY WAS JESUS EXALTED?

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- Jesus was exalted because He:
  - Fulfilled the covenant
  - God wanted us to KNOW that it was FINISHED!
- ROMANS 1:1-4



# WHAT IS EXALTATION?

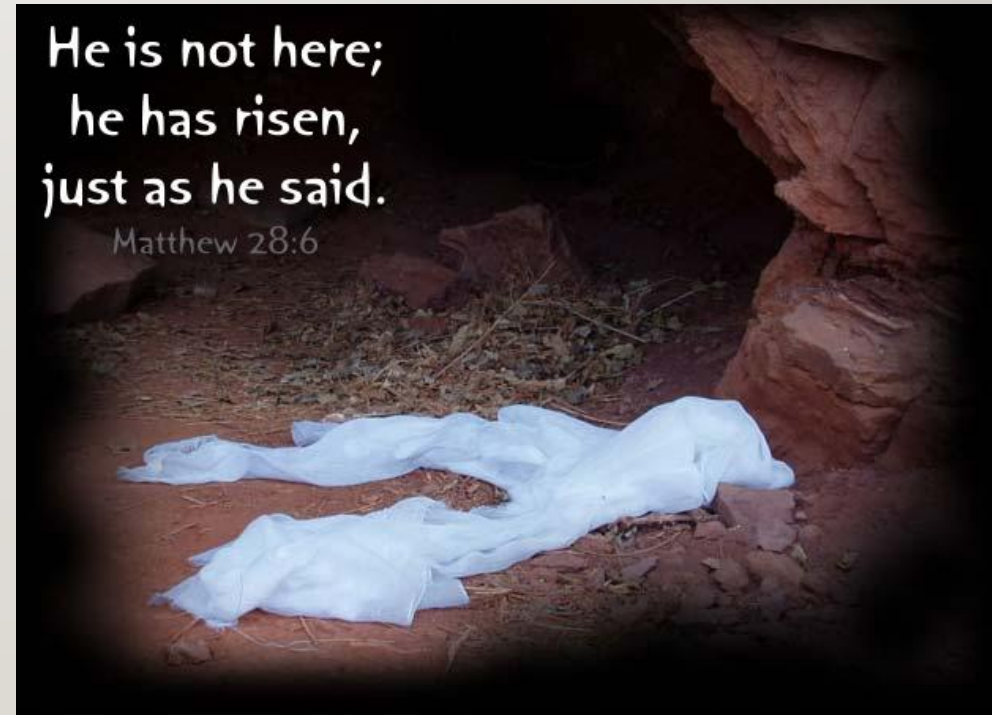
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- Rising again from the dead
- Ascension
- Seated at the Right Hand of the Father
- Coming Again to Judge the World

# RISING AGAIN FROM THE DEAD

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- Death could not hold Him or corrupt Him
- He rose from the dead by His own power
- He was declared to be the Son of God, Who defeated death and is Lord



# ASCENSION

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- Jesus' ascension shows His victory over our enemies
- He is preparing a place for His people!

# SEATED AT THE RIGHT HAND

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- Jesus is seated at God the Father's right hand
  - A place of power and authority
  - He is king – ruling
  - He is priest— interceding
  - He is prophet – keeping His Word
