1. What comes to mind when you hear "majesty"? What does it mean to you that God is majestic?
2. If someone were to try to understand who God is based on listening to your prayers from this past week, what caricature might they come up with? Sugar Daddy? Santa Claus? Genie in a bottle? Grand Old Man in the clouds? Someone too busy to listen and care? Personal miracle worker? Angry step-father? BFF? Stoic immigration officer? Read John 6, it is a long chapter but stick with it. Take note of the different conceptions people had of Jesus. What were the misconceptions? Did anyone get it right?
3. How might you respond to someone who asks, "If God is so awesome, why is He so hard to find when I need Him most?"
4. What does it mean to say "God is beautiful"? In what ways is God beautiful? How is that different or the same as the physical beauty found in the world?
5. How do you "see" (acknowledge) God's majesty, greatness and beauty?
6. How do you "know" (experience) these attributes of God?
7. How do you "stand before God in awe?" Share in your group different ways in which you savor God's greatness and majesty. Compare and contrast the differences within your group. Is one way right or better than another? Why do you think we, as individuals, approach God differently?
