Psalms 139

Three things we can learn about God:

1. God knows us! (v.1)

A. What does it mean that God knows us?

1. God's 'knowledge' of us is a relational knowledge. (Jn 10:14, 24)

2. God knows everything there is to know about us.

a. God knows what we think. (Ps 94:11)

b. God knows what we do!

c. God knows where we go!

d. God knows what we say!

2. God is with us! (v.7-12)

A. Where can I go from your Spirit? The answer is nowhere. (Rom 8:38-39)

B. David knew the Lord was always at his side. Why?

1. He believed the promises contained in God's Word because He trusted God!

2. He experienced the Lord's presence with him. (Isa 43:3)

3. God made us! (v.13-18)

A. This Psalm is literally a scientific treatise on the creation and development of the human body in the womb of a mother.

B. God, YOU, made us.

C. The word translated 'wonderfully' can also be translated different, set apart, or unique

"The womb of the mother is a holy of holies where God is at work. How tragic that we turn [this sacred place] into a tomb, this holy of holies into a holocaust." -Dr. Warren Wiersbe

D. The Hebrew word used here for 'frame' is a reference to our skeleton. (I Cor 1:27-29)

[This verse] means that God wired together what would become every physical ability and every physical disability—woven into your being so that we would uniquely give Him glory and uniquely have to depend upon him for our own unique needs—and find in Him a faithful, gracious, sovereign Lord. -Dr. Stephen Davey
