IX. No Regrets! (II Tim 4:6-15)

⁶For I am already being poured out like a drink offering, and the time has come for my departure. ⁷I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith. ⁸Now there is in store for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous Judge, will award to me on that day—and not only to me, but also to all who have longed for his appearing.

A. If you want to live your life with no regrets you must do three things:

1. You must commit!
2. You must engage!
3. You must consider!

B. What does it mean to commit? (v.6)

“For I am already being poured out like a drink offering, and the time has come for my departure.”

C. What does it mean to engage? (v.7)

“I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith.”

1. Paul engaged in the fight! (Matthew 11:12; Ephesians 6:12)

2. Paul finished the race! (1 Corinthians 9:24-27; Hebrews 11:13-16)

3. Paul kept the faith! (Hebrews 12:1-3)

D. What does it mean to consider? (v.8)

“Now there is in store for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous Judge, will award to me on that day—and not only to me, but also to all who have longed for his appearing.”
