<i>Passover</i>	<i>March 26, 2013</i>	Eat the Passover Lev. 23:4-5	Deliverance from death of firstborn by death of a lamb	Christ our Passover has been sacrificed 1 Cor. 5:7
<i>Unleavened bread</i>	<i>March 27- April 2, 2013</i>	Rest on the first and seventh days - eat unleavened bread for seven days - Lev. 23:6-8	Eating unleavened bread recalling a hasty deliverance from Egypt	Sinlessness of Christ 2 Cor. 5:21
<i>First fruits</i>	<i>March 28, 2013</i>	Wave the sheaf of the first fruits of the harvest and offer sacrifices - Lev. 23:9-14	Dedication of first portion of the harvest	Resurrection of Christ 1 Cor. 15:20-23
<i>Pentecost</i>	<i>May 15, 2013</i>	Offer two loaves of bread with leaven - offer sacrifices- rest Lev. 23:15-22	Fifty days after first fruits	Pouring out of the Holy Spirit on the church Acts 1:5, 2:1-4
<i>Trumpets</i>	<i>Sept. 5, 2013</i>	Rest - blow trumpets - present an offering by fire Lev. 23:23-25	Blowing the shofar - Jewish civil New Year	Rapture of believers Mt. 24:31, 1 Cor. 15:52, 1 Thess. 4:16
<i>Day of Atonement</i>	<i>Sept. 14, 2013</i>	Rest - fast - present an offering by fire Lev. 23:26-32	High Priest enters the Holy of Holies to offer blood for forgiveness	Israel will return to her Messiah and be saved Romans 11:26-27
<i>Tabernacles</i>	<i>Sept. 19-26, 2013</i>	Rest on first and eighth day - for seven days present an offering by fire - live in booths Lev. 23:33-43	Provision in wilderness wanderings on way to Promised Land	Christ's reign on earth and new heaven and new earth Rev. 11:15-17, 21:1-4
