1. What insight, principle, or observation from this weekend's message did you find most helpful, eye-opening, troubling?

4. What is your biggest fear about being a part of a community group? What are you hoping most to receive or to contribute to your community group?
5. Briefly share one of the most recent things that God has taught you?
6. Did you have a defining moment where you first realized that your faith demanded that you play an active role in the mission of the church?
