**PRACTICE**

Faith surrenders your will to God's will. What is an example of this principle at work in your past? What is an example of this for something you desire for your present or future?

Faith has present confidence in future unfulfilled promises. What are some yet-to-be-fulfilled promises of God? How do you display confidence in those promises in your life?

**CHANGE**

Faith doesn't flesh out as perfection, yet we still need to daily pursue growth in Christ-likeness. How have you been growing in Christ-like character lately? In what way do you specifically need to grow in this next season?
