- I. Jesus is sovereign over the process. Mark 1:17, 20; John 15:16; 1 Corinthians 3:6–8
  
- II. A disciple counts the cost. Mark 1:17–18; Luke 9:23–26
  
- III. A disciple follows Jesus. Mark 1:17a; John 15:5, 7; Acts 2:37–38, 42
  
- IV. Jesus gives His disciples a primary task. Mark 1:17b; John 20:21; Matthew 28:19–20;  
2 Timothy 2:2
