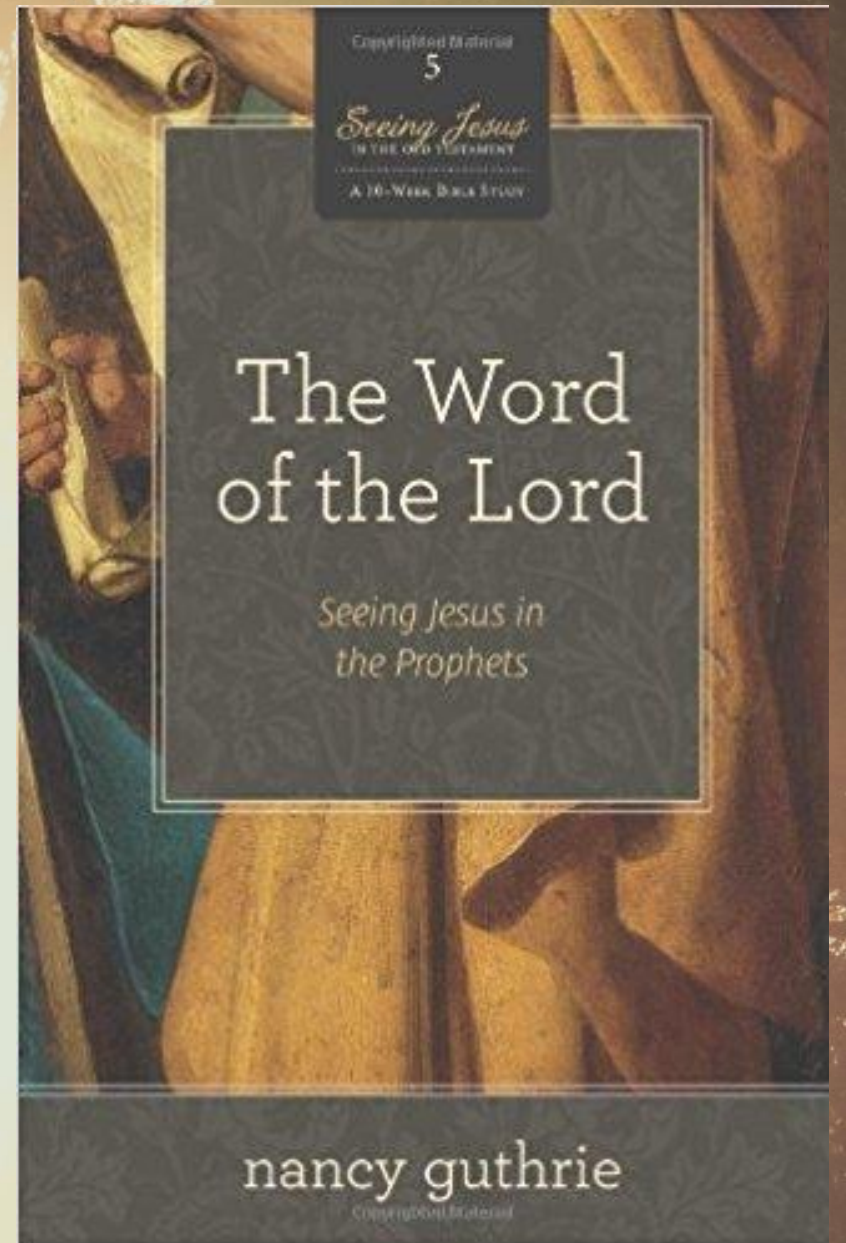

Background

- Ezekiel – “ God strengthens” or “May God strengthen”
- Priest
- Exile from 2nd wave
- Prophetic ministry living in community of exiled Judeans by Chebar canal in Babylon
- Prophet to exiles & to the Judeans still in Jerusalem
- Speaks out against 7 foreign nations

3 Parts & Purpose

- Prophecies against the “rebellious house” of Israel for their idolatry
- Oracles against foreign nations
- Prophecies of restoration
- Oracles defend the character of God’s holiness
- Primary purpose: restore God’s glory before his people who rejected it in full view of the watching nations.
 - Chapter 36:22-32

Ezekiel's Visions

1st Vision: Glory of the LORD descends "*Ezekiel has seen that God's presence among his people is not confined to an architectural structure in Jerusalem.*"

- 2nd Vision: Glory of the LORD departs
- 3rd Vision: Glory of the LORD returns
