The Centrality of the Resurrection

1. It affirms the reality of the good news of Christ (v.1-11)
2. It affirms the certainty of a bodily resurrection (v.12-19)
3. It affirms the resurrection of believer's that already died (v.20-28)
4. It affirms that without the resurrection, living by Christian values is meaningless (v.29-34)
5. It affirms that God has the power to control the natural and the spiritual world (v.35-54)
6. It affirms the truth of God and must inspire us to make a stand for Him (v.55-58)
