Sermon Title: The Life of David “The Blessing of a Radical Redemptive Recovery”
Scripture Reading: 1 SAMUEL 30:18-31

1. David's Spoil the plundering of Grace by the victory of Christ: 1 Sam 30:20/
Matt 12:29
 - a. God wrought the Victory through David - 1 Sam 25:28c/Neh 4:20/Josh 23:10
 - b. It was the plunder of Gods enemies - vs 26/Prov 13:22

2. The Kings gracious act exposes the selfish servants: 1 Sam 30:32
 - a. Grace is strange to the carnal mind - 1 Cor 2:14
 - b. Grace is offensive to the self - important - 1 Cor 1:18-29/Matt 14:15
 - c. Every member of the body important - 1 Cor 12:18, 11, 7-13

3. There is a difference between performance and agreement based relationship: vs 26
 - a. The parable of the workers agreement - vs Matt 20:1-2
 - b. The price determined before hand - vs Matt 20:10-13
 - c. The payment is an act of righteousness by the owner - vs Matt 20:15-16

4. The effects of a Radical redemptive recovery: vs 26
 - a. A revelation of the work of God - vs 26a/1 Chron 29:12-14
 - b. An appreciation for being kept by God - vs 26b/Jude 1:1/Jer 50:20
 - c. The honor of being used by God - vs 26c /2 Tim 3:21

5. A compelling drive to bless others because of it: vs 26-31 - Two lepers
 - a. The death of Christ opens the heavenly storehouse - Col 2:2
 - b. The riches and spoils of Christ are for all his people - Is 53:12
