

Psalm 10
"A Prayer for the Overthrow of the Wicked"

Main idea: Though wicked people victimize the helpless, God, our eternal King, will vindicate the righteous and end all wickedness.

I. Sometimes, God seems distant (1).

II. We live in a world that is terrorized by wicked people; this can be overwhelming (2-11).

A. The wicked are arrogant in their "independence" from God (2-7).

B. The wicked are violent (8-11).

III. In faith, we cry for God to act (12-15).

A. Our appeal is based on the honor of God (12-13).

B. God has rescued in the past; He will do it again (14-15).

IV. God, the eternal King, will right all wrongs (16-18).

A. God is sovereign over all things (16).

B. We can have confidence that God will do justice to the afflicted and end all wickedness (17-18).
