

Psalm 7

An Appeal of the Innocent Before the Righteous Judge

Main idea:

The people of God who walk in their integrity may pray with confidence for the LORD to vindicate them by turning the malicious schemes of the wicked back on the wicked themselves.

- I. Those who trust in the Lord God may appeal to him for deliverance in times of danger(1-2).
- II. In appealing to the righteous judge to vindicate them, the righteous must be innocent(3-9).
- III. By observing how God spoils the plans of the wicked, the righteous may renew their confidence in the righteousness of God(10-17).
- IV. The righteous may rightly resolve to sing praises to the Lord Most High according to His righteousness(17).
