Sermon Title: The Life of David “ESTABLISHING THE KINGDOM”

Scripture Reading: 2 Samuel 3:1-21

1. **The residual effects of the old man/flesh** - 2 Sam 23:1a
 - a. The penalty of sin removed at the Cross - Rom 6:12
 - b. Satan's powers limited by the Cross - Heb 2:14/Rev 20:1
 - c. Inward sin remains a struggle - Rom 7:22-23
 - d. The dominion is the believers through Christ - 1 John 3:8; 4:4/Gen 25:23

2. **The Defiance of the Flesh to submit to the Spirit:** 2 Sam 2:7-10
 - a. The authority of the flesh is false and short lived - vs 10/15-17 (Captains/12s)
 - b. The attempt at controlling the kingdom is futile - 2 Sam 3:30-31
 - c. The False King exposed to have no power - 2 Sam 3:7:11
 - d. David demands His wife Micah back - 2 Sam 3:14-16

3. **Abner the Satanic power behind the false King destroyed:** 2 Sam 3:25-27
 - a. The power behind Rulers is either of God or demonic - 2 Thess 2:9/1 John 4:6
 - b. They are inspired only to oppose the truth of Christ - Rev 16:13-14
 - c. The False King assassinated - 2 Sam 4:1-2; 5-8 - Why? - Ps 2:6-7, 10

4. **David retains his integrity of not touching Gods anointed:** 2 Sam 4:9-12
 - a. Christ came not to condemn the world - John 3:17-18
 - b. The elect will hear believe and be gathered to the King - 2 Sam 5:1-3/John 5:24
