Romans 8:20-21 For the creation was subjected to futility, not willingly, but because of Him who subjected it, in hope that the creation itself also will be set free from its slavery to corruption into the freedom of the glory of the children of God.

Romans 8:22-23 For we know that the whole creation groans and suffers the pains of childbirth together until now. And not only this, but also we ourselves, having the first fruits of the Spirit, even we ourselves groan within ourselves, waiting eagerly for our adoption as sons, the redemption of our body.

Romans 8:24-25 For **in hope we have been saved**, but hope that is seen is not hope; for who hopes for what he already sees? But if we hope for what we do not see, with perseverance **we wait eagerly for it.**

Applications

- We must understand that suffering for Christ now is worth eternal rewards later.
- We must learn to live by faith and not by sight.

Suffering Now Is Worth Eternal Reward

2 Cor. 4:16-18 Therefore we do not lose heart, but though our outer man is decaying, yet our inner man is being renewed day by day. **For momentary, light affliction is producing for us an eternal weight of glory far beyond all comparison**, while we look not at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen; for the things which are seen are temporal, but the things which are not seen are eternal.

Habakkuk 2:2-4 Then the LORD answered me and said, "Record the vision and inscribe it on tablets, that the one who reads it may run. For the vision is yet for the appointed time; it hastens toward the goal and **it will not fail**. Though it tarries, wait for it; for it will certainly come, **it will not fail**. Though it tarries, wait for it; For it will certainly come, it will not delay. "Behold, as for the proud one, His soul is not right within him; **But the righteous will live by his faith.**

2 Cor. 5:5-8 Now He who prepared us for this very purpose is God, who gave to us the Spirit as a pledge.
