Sermon Title: "THE BLOODY MAN OF WAR"

Scripture Reading: 1 Chronicle 22:1-19

1. **David was a man of war - 1 Chron 22:8/28:3 - 3 wars to consider!**
 - a. Heaven - The Heart - The Cross - Rev 12:7/James 4:1-3/Col 2:15, 14
 - b. David's battles point to the cross work of Christ - Moses/Joshua/etc.,
 - c. The Lord is a man of War - Ex 15:1-3 (red sea/blood atonement)

2. **The Temple motif signifies peace and rest - 1 Chron 22:9a,b,c**
 - a. Solomon points to the eschatological Jerusalem - (foundation peace) Rev 21:1-5
 - b. The Triumph of the cross results in peace for the people of God - Eph 2:13-16/
Ex 15:13-18
 - c. The Nature of Christ rule in the hearts of His elect - Is 9:6/John 16:33

3. **David prepared the material for the Temple - 1 Chron 22:5, 14-16**
 - a. In His troubles and death - Is 53:10-12/Ps 132:1-5; 8:10; 17-18
 - b. Exceeding riches through Stuffing - 1 Chron 22:14, 16/Col 2:1-2
 - c. The pattern given through suffering - 1 Chron 28:10-11/1 Peter 1:10-11
 - d. He did it with all his might - 1 Chron 29:2-3

4. **Solomon the man of Rest - A type of the risen Christ - 1 Kings 8:12-20**
 - a. Confirmed by His Father - 1 Chron 22:9-10
 - b. Called to be Faithful - 1 Chron 22:11-13 - (1 Chron 28:20)
 - c. Completed the task - 1 Kings 6:7-14
 - d. The Saints are to help in the work - 1 Chron 22:18
