



How to use Talk It Over:

Talking through the message during the week helps you and your Neighborhood Group turn what God is saying to you into action steps. Begin with the key questions, add any optional scriptures and questions if needed, and then wrap up by deciding on your next steps.

Pastor Ryan's Main Idea

“Jesus is the Door of Grace that leads to life”

Key Questions:

- What part of the service did you really identify with and why? JarRon's story? Ryan's message? The music?
- How does the message of Grace make you feel after hearing about Jesus as the door of Grace?
- Read John 10:9. Pastor Ryan described this passage not simply as salvation but God's promise for ongoing spiritual growth and life. Share How how God been growing you through the church.
- Why is it important to take care of yourself if you are going to grow in a relationship with God or grow in His grace? (Hebrews 4:16)
- Read John chapter 1:41-42 and discuss how God has used you or could use you in the life of other families, to help bring them Jesus, to bring them home.



Optional Questions: If needed, include one or more of these scripture and/or questions to extend your conversation.


- Discuss how Jesus Christ's exclusive claims of salvation are contrary to a pluralistic society, and why this is so offensive.
- How are you personally taking action for yourself, your family and friends to see them come home to God?
- Discuss how "The Doors of Grace" always lead to life
- Discuss how "The Doors of Guilt" lead to shame in your own life.
- Read and discuss Exodus chapter 12, how the Passover was a door of Grace for God's people, and is what we celebrate in communion.

Next Steps:

- Evaluate how you use your time in a given week with God and others. Make a plan that reflects your priorities. First to yourself, your family and your friends.
