

## Pastor's Note:

"Appoint elders..." (Titus 1:5). Paul commanded Titus to appoint, or "ordain" elders. Elders and pastors must be appointed to the office of "overseer" by someone else other than themselves. People cannot just declare themselves to be pastors. The New Testament teaches that men are called to be elders by the Holy Spirit, other elders in keeping with biblical qualifications, as affirmed by the saints in a given local church.

An elder has control of his family (1:6-7a).

1. An elder is above approach.  
*"appoint elders...if any man is above reproach"*
2. An elder is committed to his wife.  
*"the husband of one wife..."*
3. An elder is a male.  
*"elders...man...husband" (cf. 1 Timothy 2:9-15; 1 Corinthians 14:34-35)*
4. An elder has faithful children.  
*"having faithful children not accused of dissipation or insubordination" (cf. 1 Timothy 3:4-5)*
