Sermon Title: "The Good Samaritan" A Certain man and a Certain Samaritan

Scripture Reading: Luke 10:25-37

1. **A subtle rebuke to a presumptuous self-justifying lawyer.**
(nom-ik-os') an expert in Mosaic Law. (25-29)
 - a) A right answer sometimes needs an indirect correction in the heart. Proverbs 25:7/Luke 16:15; 18:9
 - b) The Lawyers two-part answer, show of knowledge, a lack of wisdom to not know his neighbor. (Deut 6:5/Lev 19:18/1 Cor 8:1b)
 - c) Cross examined by The Son of God. In case law, the first to speak seems right, until someone comes forward and cross – examines Proverbs 18:7
 2. **An 18 mile decent/Life's Road with many trials, toils and snares. The worst being the anti-evangelical religionist.** (30-32)
 - a) Have you been robbed, stripped, wounded and left for dead? Song of Solomon 5:6-7/John 10:10
 - b) (By chance) A priest walked on the other side. "A chosen officer or prince with the capacity to draw near to
 - c) A Levite only looked, "A member of the Hebrew tribe of Levi, especially of that part of it that provided assistants to the priests in the worship in the Jewish temple." Is 65:5
 3. **A Samaritan, Despised by the Jews and Rejected. Decedents of Jacob to whom Christ came from.** John 4:12, 20/Mt 1:1-2 (33-36)
 - a) A gospel connection! Doing the right thing for the afflicted -1 John 3:18/Romans 12:9/Psalm 97:10
 - b) Healing, oil, wine, an Inn and a cost- Psalm 147:3/Song of Solomon 1:3/1 Cor 1:23-26
 - c) Who is this Samaritan? From where did he journey Ezekiel 16:6/Philippians 2:5-8/2 Cor 8:9
- *Application** "go, and do thou likewise" Preach the word; be prepared in season and out of season; correct, rebuke and encourage with great patience and careful instruction. 2 Tim 4:2
