TILL [Get the soil ready]

- Tada! We're done! It's been a great journey through Storyline. What were your favorite stories? What did you learn? Is there something you've been able to apply to your life?
- In 2 Peter 1, he writes that it is good to be reminded of God's principles for us. What do you need to remind one another?

SOW [What God wants us to hear]

- Before he met Jesus, what life achievements did Paul have (see Philippians 3 if you need help)?
- At that point in his life, would he have considered himself weak or strong?
- How did God intervene in his life (see Acts 9)?



Thorn [Working the truth into our hearts]

- From 2 Cor. 12:7-10, what did Paul gain by his “thorn in the flesh?”

- Do you think that Paul would give up his thorn if he could? Why or why not?

Harvest [Where the fruit is seen]

- Do you have any thorns?

- Any weaknesses, shortcomings, lack of talent, etc?

- Any besetting sins that you just can't seem to defeat?

- Will you identify, own, and use them? Are you willing to let God work in spite of your weaknesses?
