CENTRAL TRUTH: I can banish fear and take my journey into the unknown because God is faithful.

GETTING STARTED

1. Share an experience from your life when someone was truly faithful to you.

DIGGING DEEPER

2. What does it mean for God to be faithful? Define "the faithfulness of God."
3. Take time to share rich stories of God's faithfulness. How has God proven himself faithful in your life? In your family? In the lives of others? In our church? In the Scripture?
4. In Deuteronomy 1:30, Moses gives three reasons why fear-ridden Israel can move forward into the unknown, trusting in God's faithfulness. As you consider your own future, which of the reasons in v. 30 (below) gives you the most comfort and courage to face any uncertainties?
 - Because God is faithful to go before me.
 - Because God is faithful to fight for me himself.
 - Because God has been faithful throughout my past.

TAKING IT HOME

5. What one insight from the teaching seems most personally significant to you right now?
6. Share in a time of extended worship and prayer. In prayer, acknowledge the specific ways that God has been faithful in your life, in the lives of others, in our church, in the world, etc. If possible, sing songs declaring God's faithfulness.
