

- God reveals His method for our reconciliation in verse 20b: “having made peace through the blood of His cross.” That is, that God was in Christ reconciling the world to Himself, not imputing their trespasses to them, and has committed to us the word of reconciliation. For He made Him who knew no sin to be sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him. 2 Corinthians 5:19, 21
- To present you holy in His sight, without blemish and free from accusation.” (v.21)

God takes great joy in our reconciliation. His Son endured the cross “for the joy set before Him” (Hebrews 12:2).

### Sacrificial Service for Christ (1:24-29)

“And not only that, but we also glory in tribulations, knowing that tribulation produces perseverance” (Romans 5:3);

“but rejoice to the extent that you partake of Christ’s sufferings, that when his glory is revealed, you may also be glad with exceeding joy” (1 Peter 4:13)

“So they departed from the presence of the council, rejoicing that they were counted worthy to suffer shame for His name” (Acts 5:41)

“I will also give You as a light to the Gentiles, that You should be My salvation to the ends of the earth.” (Isaiah 49:6)

“But speaking the truth in love, my grow up in all things into Him who is the head – Christ” (Ephesians 4:15)

# The Supremacy of the Person of Christ

He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn over all creation. For by Him all things were created that are in heaven and that are on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers. All things were created through Him and for Him. And He is before all things, and in Him all things consist. He is the head of the body, the church, who is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead, that in all things He may have the preeminence.

Paul covers three thoughts about Jesus in these four verses:

His relation to God (Colossians 1:15)

**No one has seen God at any time. God the only Son, who is at the Father's side, He has made Him known. John 1:18**  
**The Son is the radiance of God's glory and the exact representation of His being. Hebrews 1:3**

His relation to Creation (Colossians 1:16-17)

**Christ is superior in creation because He is the sustainer: "He is before all things, and in Him all things hold together." (v.17)**  
**All things were made through Him, and without Him nothing was made that was made. John 1:3**  
**The perfect tense in the Greek tell us that he continues even now to hold all things together and without Him things would disintegrate.**

His relation to the Church (Colossians 1:18)

- **"And He is the head of the body, the church." (v.18a)**
- **"The firstborn from the dead, that in all things He may have preeminence" (v18b)**

## Reconciled in Christ (Colossians 1:19-23)

**For it pleased the Father that in Him all the fullness should dwell, and by Him to reconcile all things to Himself, by Him, whether things on earth or things in heaven, having made peace through the blood of His cross. And you, who once were alienated and enemies in your mind by wicked works, yet now He has reconciled, in the body of His flesh through death, to present you holy, and blameless, and above reproach in His sight— if indeed you continue in the faith, grounded and steadfast, and are not moved away from the hope of the gospel which you heard, which was preached to every creature under heaven, of which I, Paul, became a minister.**

- For in Christ all the fullness of the Deity lives in bodily form. Colossians 2:9
- And that He might reconcile them both to God in one body through the cross, thereby putting to death the enmity. Ephesians 2:16
- For if when we were enemies we were reconciled to God through the death of His Son, much more, having been reconciled, we shall be saved by His life. Romans 5:10
