**CENTRAL TRUTH:** Building a healthy and thriving church that pleases God is a worthwhile investment!

### GETTING STARTED

1. What would you want to see at Jefferson or at any other church that would be so compelling that it would fire you up to come to every week? What would make Jefferson a more beautiful and healthy church? What kind of church do you envision us to be?

### DIGGING DEEPER

2. **READ Acts 2:42-47** and answer the following questions:
  - a. List some of the things the early church fully participated in from our text?
  - b. From a scale of 1-5 (1 being the worst and 5 being the best), how are we doing as a church in these areas?
    - A commitment to learning God’s Word
    - A commitment to fellowship and the breaking of bread
    - A commitment to prayer
    - Acknowledgment of the fear and presence of God
    - A commitment to generous giving
    - A love for the lost coming to faith
  - c. What can we do to make our church a more beautiful and healthy church? What part can you play in the coming weeks, months, or year? How can we create pockets of Acts 2 throughout the church?
  - d. Do you agree with the statement, “Our church doesn’t go as far as the pastor wants it to go. It only goes as far as the people want it to go.”
3. **Commitment for 2018:** Is there one area from Acts 2:42-47 you would like to commit to - personally or corporately as we look ahead to 2018?
