Sermon Title: "The God of Scripture and The Hope of Glory"

Scripture Reading: Romans 15:1-13

1. **A cross-centered - Christ centered life, as the key, to unity of the body:** vs 5-7
 - a. Full reception with a mission - Philemon 1:12, 17
 - b. Foreshadowed - patterned - modeled - typified - (The mix multitude)

2. **The Clarity and Comfort of scripture concerning the kingdom:** vs 4
(Scriptures Impact)
 - a. Learning - vs Ps 19:7-9/John 6:45 - as students/disciples
 - b. Patience - Ps 37:7 - trained - Heb 12:1-2 - Wait - Noah/Abraham/Moses
 - c. Comfort/Strength - (His faithfulness to come through) Jer 15:16
 - d. Producing hope - (A firm commitment to future deliverances) Heb 11:35, 39-40

3. **The Revelation of Christ and the hope of the gospel in it:** vs 8-12
(Rhythm of redemption)
 - a. The scriptures are about Christ - Ps 40:7/John 5:39/Rev 19:10 - Law/Ps/Prophets - (Tanakh)
 - b. He appears to be loved and lauded by Jew/Gentile - vs 11 Ps 18:43-44/Dan 3:25/
Eph 2:14-16
 - c. Their hope is in the promise of the resurrection - Job 19/Is19:26/Dan 12:1-2

4. **The joy and hope of the gospel is sustained by God himself:** vs 13
 - a. *Filled with revelations* of Christ - Acts 7:55 - Full of the holy Ghost
 - b. *Creating a joy* and hope against the suffering - Acts 5:41-42
 - c. *Increasing your hope* in HIM away from the world - 1 Peter 1:8
