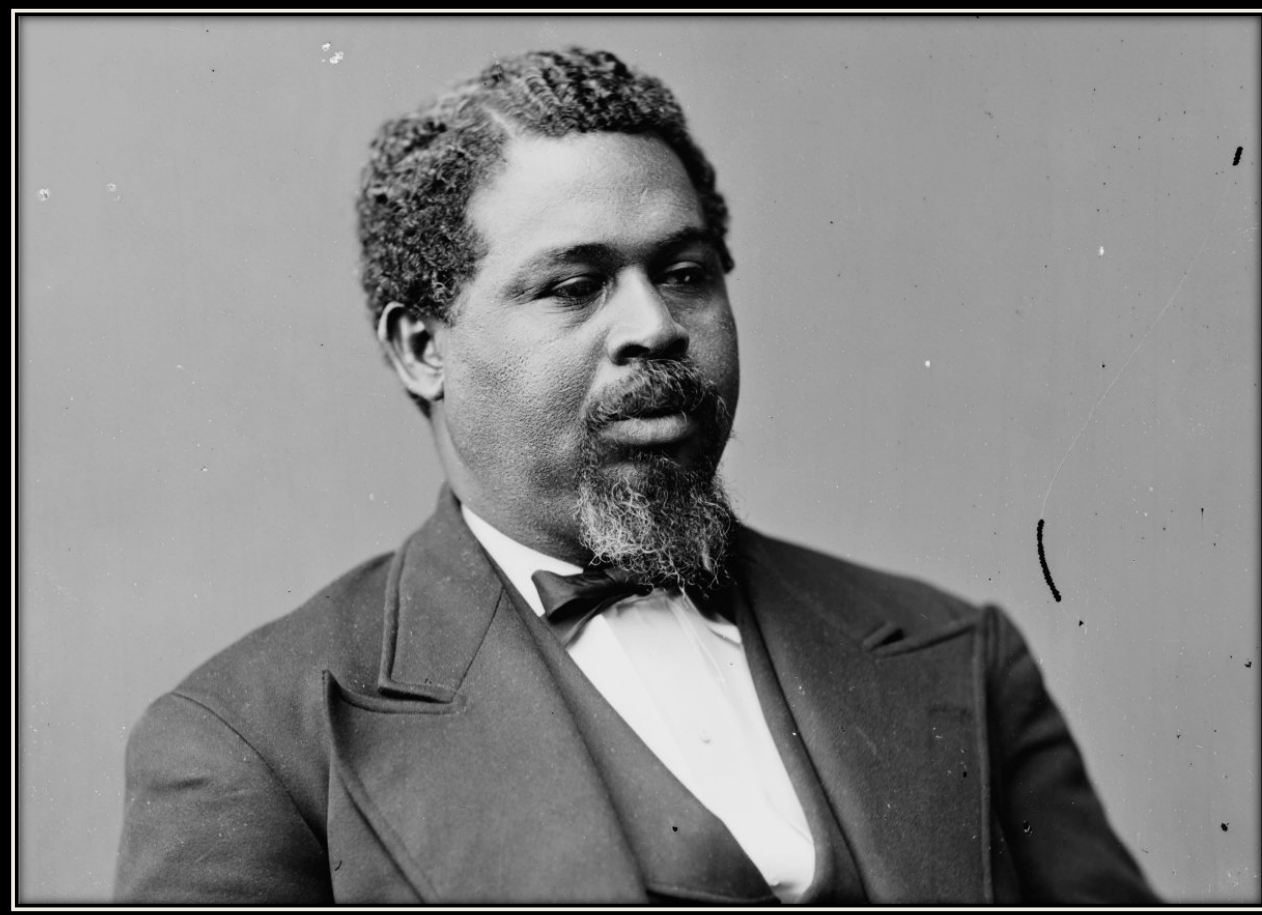




# MORE THAN CONQUERORS

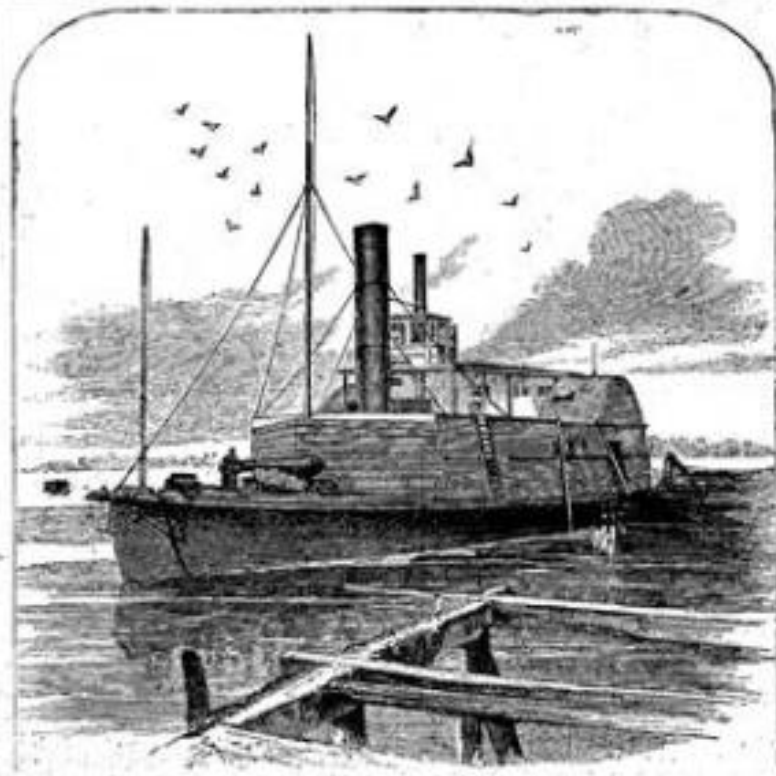
