WEEK 3: HOW CAN CHRISTIANS TRUST A 2000-YEAR OLD DOCUMENT AS THE WORD OF GOD?

DISCOVER (PRE-WORK)

Before and while you read these passages ask the Spirit of God to illuminate your heart and mind and bring conviction and clarity of his truth for your life. Take some time during you own personal study to read through these four key questions:

1. Who is God (what does this passage tell me about God's character)?
2. What Has God Done (how do I see God's character in action here)?
3. Who Am I (how does God's character and action shape how I see myself)?
4. What Do I Do (if I believe 1-3 how would I respond and relate to others)?

Scripture: 2 Timothy 3:14-17; 2 Peter 1:19-21; 1 Thessalonians 2:13; Psalms 19:7-11; 119:1-24 (Read all of 119 if you have the time)

QUESTION: What did you DISCOVER during your study?

NURTURE

Confess out loud to one another areas of personal struggle or unbelief that the Spirit revealed during your personal study.

In light of this week's sermon, consider these questions together:

1. How does your interaction with God's Word - The Bible - reveal what you believe about it?
2. How do these passages of Scripture or the teaching from Sunday change your perspective of God's Word?

3. In what ways have you experienced God speak to you through His Word?

4. How is the Spirit of God leading you to respond in light of what God's Word says?

During this time, let each person share how or where they need to repent and believe the truth of God revealed to them in Jesus. You may need to guide each other to what is true of God and ourselves in light of what Jesus has done. For this week, refer to how Jesus is the True WORD of God made flesh who affirmed the Scriptures as the Word of God; fulfilled them as the true display of God and obeyed them perfectly on our behalf to be our substitute. He makes the written Word come alive in our hearts as we turn to him by faith to reveal the truth of God and to change our hearts by His Spirit.

QUESTION: How will you REPENT and BELIEVE the gospel?

ACT

In light of your time together, what steps will you take to act on your new discoveries and affirmed beliefs?

Consider these questions:

1. How is your posture to God's Word - The Bible - changing?
2. How will you commit to read and submit to God's Word now?
3. What relationships need to be addressed with the truths of God's Word?
4. Take some time to pray through a section of God's Word that deeply impacted you.

QUESTION: What will you DO and who will you TELL about what God has done?
