Growth Questions for 3/14 – 3/21

1. What insight, principle, or observation from this weekend's message did you find most helpful, eye-opening, troubling?
2. After the discussion about Patrick's level of education, as it relates to ministry and the Bible, how do you feel you are most effectively equipped to reach other for Christ?
3. What does the blessing in Numbers 6:24-26 ask God to do? List the requests and discuss how each can change a person's life.
4. How could daily praying Numbers 6:24-26 change your mindset and attitude toward people around you that are difficult and potentially hostile toward the Gospel?
5. Patrick had a deep love for the people he was trying to reach. How can developing a consistent prayer directive for others change your level of involvement and awareness of people far from God?
6. Discuss the theme and concept of 'peace' through the Bible. Where does peace come from? Can a person know peace apart from God? See Psalm 29:11, Romans 5:1, Ephesians 2:17, Philippians 4:7, 9.
