

Benefits to the Brethren
Hebrews 2:10-18

Aim: Give reasons to not neglect the great salvation provided by the Son of God who became Jesus, the Son of Man, by first of all knowing what it is, choosing to believe it, and then live according to it.

Premises for conclusion: #1—Jesus is superior to the angels as the Son of God.
#2—Jesus did not become inferior by becoming the Son of Man.

Conclusions: Because the Son of God became the Son of Man, believers in Jesus become _____.

1. **Sons** being brought to glory. (2:10)

2. **Sanctified** by He who sanctifies. (2:11a)

3. **Brethren** that Jesus is unashamed of. (vs. 11b)

4. **Sharers** in his humanity. (vs. 12-13)

5. **Freed** from their fear of death (vs. 14-16)

6. **Forgiven** of their sins (vs. 17)

7. **Helped** when tempted. (vs. 18)
