**Theme:** The church's teachers must lead God's people to persevere in the true gospel that produces godliness, even in the face of false teachers and wrong doctrine.

### **I. The wrong use of the Law (1:3-7)**

- A. Confront the false teachers
  
- B. Exposing false teaching
  - 1. No strange doctrines, myths or endless genealogies
  - 2. No mere speculation that does not further the faith
  
- C. Goal of gospel teaching
  - 1. Pure heart that produces love
  - 2. Good conscience
  - 3. Sincere faith
  
- D. Avoid straying from godliness
  - 1. Preferring fruitless discussions
  - 2. Preferring expertise and legalism
  - 3. Proving foolish

### **II. The right use of the Law (1:8-11)**

- A. Confront the ungodly
  
- B. Expose ungodliness
  - 1. Identify and convict of sin
  - 2. Reveal guilt and condemnation
  - 3. Move to repentance and faith
