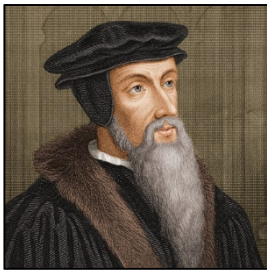

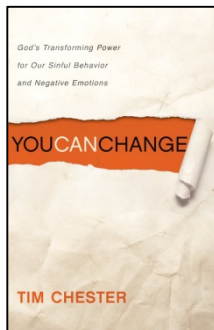
AN INTRODUCTION
