Gods Glory Alone

[Giving glory to God alone] means feeling and thinking and acting in ways that reflect His greatness, that make much of God . . . John Piper

3. Does it ever bother you that it's "all about Him"? Why Him and not us? How can living to please God be better for us than trying to make ourselves happy?
4. Read 1 Corinthians 6:19-20 and 2 Corinthians 5:14-15. Why do you think the Apostle Paul is so insistent in these verses that Jesus' death makes a difference in what and who we live for?
5. What are ways we can subtly - or not so subtly - get people to notice us and be impressed? How does this tend to show up in your life?
6. How can you invite people you know to be more impressed with God than with you?
