Ruth and the four-fold blessing – 2:19-20; 3:10; 4:14

Blessing the source of our blessings - because....

Ps 34:1-7; 103:1; 104:1/Ezekiel 3:12/Eph 1:3

Declare the blessings of the source upon the blessed –

Ps 1:1; 2:12; 16:7; 28:6; 32:1; 33:12; 41:2; 65:4

Emulating the blessing upon others –that is to (GIVE)

Acts 20:31/Luke 6:37/Matt 25:34-40/Matt 5:44-48

The Psalms were motivated by a blessed man who was determined to bless the source of his blessings and be a blessing.” 2 Sam 6:18-20/1 Chron 29:10-16/1 Chron 15:13-15/Ps 21:1-7

3. The grounds of blessing – To understand the ground of blessing – Grace/Mercy –
 - a. First the bounty of God
 - b. A right and obedient response – 2 Sam 6:11/Eph 1:3
4. The object of blessing – Creation/Humanity/Especially his people – Gen 1-2 /Psalm 33:12
5. The evidence of blessing – Thankfulness – Ps 100:4; 103:5/Rom 1:21/1 Tim 4:4
6. The obligation of the blessed – Declare Gods glory – Luke 8:39/Ps 96:1-9 (3, 6, 8)
7. The impact of blessing – Conversions – Confession – Condemnation – Rom 2:4/Luke 16:24
