**Jude 24-25**

- I. **God gets the glory in our salvation because of His guarding power (24a).**  
Romans 16:25: Now **to Him who is able to establish you according to my gospel** and the preaching of Jesus Christ, according to the revelation of the mystery kept secret since the world began

Psalm 140:4: **Keep me, O Lord**, from the hands of the wicked; preserve me from violent men, **who have purposed to make my steps stumble.**

- II. **God gets the glory in our salvation because of his sanctifying power (24b).**  
Ephesians 1:6: to the praise of the glory of His grace, **by which He made us accepted in the Beloved.**

Ephesians 1:12: that we who first trusted in Christ **should be to the praise of His glory.**

- III. **God gets the glory in our salvation because of His changeless nature (25).**

A. **His changeless glory.**

Romans 16:27: **to God, alone wise, be glory** through Jesus Christ forever. Amen.

B. **His changeless majesty.**

Psalm 104:1: **Bless the Lord**, O my soul! O Lord my God, you are very great: **You are clothed with honor and majesty.**

C. **His changeless power.**

Revelation 1:6: and has made us kings and priests to His God and Father, to Him *be glory* and **dominion forever and ever. Amen.**

D. **His changeless authority.**

1 Timothy 1:17: Now to the King eternal, immortal, invisible, to God who alone is wise, *be honor and glory* **forever and ever. Amen.**
