Deuteronomy 32:45 ⁴⁵ Moses finished speaking all these words to all Israel, ⁴⁶ and He said to them: "Set your hearts on all the words which I testify among you today, which you shall command your children to be careful to observe -- all the words of this law. ⁴⁷ "For it *is* not a futile thing for you, because it *is* your life, and by this word you shall prolong *your* days in the land which you cross over the Jordan to possess."

- Deuteronomy 8:3** ³ "So He humbled you, allowed you to hunger, and fed you with manna which you did not know nor did your fathers know, that He might make you know that man shall not live by bread alone; but man lives by every *word* that proceeds from the mouth of the LORD.

⁴⁸ Then the LORD spoke to Moses that very same day, saying: ⁴⁹ "Go up this mountain of the Abarim, Mount Nebo, which *is* in the land of Moab, across from Jericho; view the land of Canaan, which I give to the children of Israel as a possession; ⁵⁰ "and die on the mountain which you ascend, and be gathered to your people, just as Aaron your brother died on Mount Hor and was gathered to his people; ⁵¹ "because you trespassed against Me among the children of Israel at the waters of Meribah Kadesh, in the Wilderness of Zin, because you did not hallow Me in the midst of the children of Israel. ⁵² "Yet you shall see the land before *you*, though you shall not go there, into the land which I am giving to the children of Israel."

Deuteronomy 33:1 Now this *is* the blessing with which Moses the man of God blessed the children of Israel before his death. ² And he said: "The LORD came from Sinai, And dawned on them from Seir; He shone forth from Mount Paran, And He came with ten thousands of saints; From His right hand *Came* a fiery law for them. ³ Yes, He loves the people; All His saints *are* in Your hand; They sit down at Your feet; *Everyone* receives Your words. ⁴ Moses commanded a law for us, A heritage of the congregation of Jacob.

<p>¹³ And of Joseph he said: "Blessed of the LORD <i>is</i> his land, With the precious things of heaven, with the dew, And the deep lying beneath, ¹⁴ With the precious fruits of the sun, With the precious produce of the months, ¹⁵ With the best things of the ancient mountains, With the precious things of the everlasting hills, ¹⁶ With the precious things of the earth and its fullness, And the favor of Him who dwelt in the bush. Let <i>the blessing</i> come 'on the head of Joseph, And on the crown of the head of him <i>who was</i> separate from his brothers.' ¹⁷ His glory <i>is like</i> a firstborn bull, And his horns <i>like</i> the horns of the wild ox; Together with them He shall push the peoples To the ends of the earth; They <i>are</i> the ten thousands of Ephraim, And they <i>are</i> the thousands of Manasseh."</p>	<p>8.
