GETTING STARTED

- How would you like to see your prayer life grow or improve? Be specific.

DISCUSSION & APPLICATION

- Read Matthew 6:9-13. In what ways is praying the Lord's Prayer like descending a ladder?
- What is temptation, as the word is used in the Lord's Prayer? (Read James 1:13-15 for help.)
- What is God's purpose in testing us? How have you responded to such testing in your life?
- If testing is helpful, and even necessary, why should we ask to be spared from temptation?

- What does the fact that we must regularly pray for spiritual protection tell us about our lives?
- Do you tend to overstate or understate the evil one's existence and influence? What have been the implications or consequences of this in your life?
- Are you more prone to succumb to Satan's accusations or his temptations? What specific accusations or temptations are persistent struggles for you?
- How can you apply the truth of the gospel to these specific struggles with the evil one?

NEXT STEPS

- Read and meditate upon Colossians 2:13-15. Write a prayer asking God to give you greater faith in his ultimate victory over evil and the evil one.
